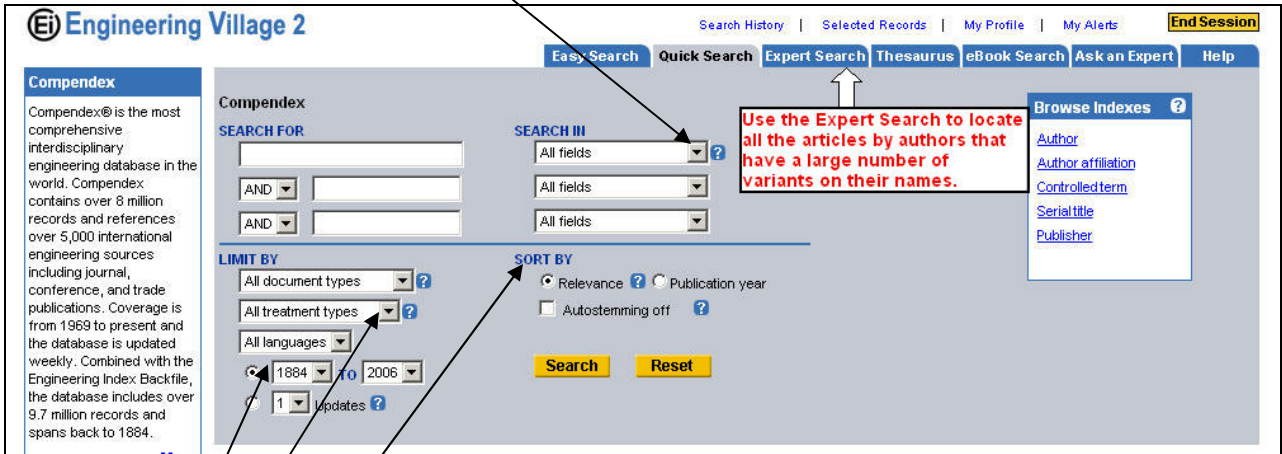

Search Fields

Limit your search to specific fields like author, author affiliation, title or more. Use the All fields for broadening your search. Using the different fields allow you to search more precisely.

Author Search Tip:

Use the Author Browse Index when doing an author search. Use the Expert Search if there are more than three variations on an author's name.



Limit Types

Default Date

What date range do you want to search? The default is 1884 - current year. Use the drop down boxes to narrow the years you search.

Treatment Type

Only want the management aspects, economic, historical, literature review, numerical, theoretical, or other aspects of a topic? Change the treatment type.

Sorting

The default is Relevance; if you want your search results to sort by date you can change that either before your search or from the search results page.

EI Control Terms: Are you getting too many results with your search? Having trouble limiting to specific concepts? Browse the EI Control Terms list. Some common control terms to help narrow a search could be:

Search History: Works great in this database. Highly recommend using it to build searches, especially when working on products made from different types of materials, when you're looking for complex ideas and how they relate to one another, or when examining emerging technologies.

Selected Records You can mark records from various searches, when you're ready to look at your selected records click on the Selected Records link. Make sure you click off the check box that says "Clear selected records on new search."

Set Up a Profile Once you set up a profile you can save searchers to rerun them some other time or on a different computer.

Alerts Set up alerts to notify you when new research in your area is added to the database.
